



Specialty Transmission Blocks

Some transmission projects have unique problems in stringing and installing the conductor with regards to the structures and attachment hardware. There are also special designed conductors requiring special types and arrangements of blocks. The sheave may require a larger diameter, a special groove radius, and the proper lining for a special conductor. Special conductors require minimum bend radius or the flare of the sheave's groove profile.

Tandem arranged blocks can help eliminate the possible damage of special designed conductors on angles and dead-ends where the bend and break-over radius is a factor. Special attachment points on the block frame allow for suspension and support of the tandem block. Again, the sheave lining is important when installing special conductors.
